This outstanding top floor apartment forms part of an impressive mansion, built circa 1760 with later Victorian additions. The property is situated on the edge of Keston Common and a short distance from picturesque Keston Village with its primary school, restaurants and local pubs. Approached by a sweeping, gated drive, the property has its own, private garden and front door. The apartment is in need of some modernisation but rooms are well proportioned and particularly notable for many period features including sash windows, high ceilings, decorative cornice and feature open fireplaces which will still allow real fires if desired. The generous reception hall leads to both bedrooms with the master benefitting from an en-suite shower room, large reception room with opening to fitted kitchen, family bathroom and separate toilet. Outside there is a single en-bloc garage and further parking for residents on the main drive. Hayes is local with its shops and railway station about one mile away. Bromley shopping centre and mainline station is about two and a half miles distance. The property is offered chain free and is being offered with a share of freehold. EPC rating: F
